Youree Drive is requesting that students have a tablet or small laptop with Wi-Fi capabilities with them beginning next year. ***This is not a requirement*** but will accelerate your student’s ability to access our Discovery Education content, Google Classroom teacher accounts, and many more educational resources. We recommend the Kindle Fire because of its relatively low cost, making them more easily replaced if damaged or lost. The school/district will not be responsible for loss, theft, or damage, of these items and they may only be used in the classroom, for educational purposes, and when designated by individual teachers. The tablet/laptop will be able to connect to school WiFi while on campus and will allow students to access these valuable resources at home or from other areas with WiFi coverage while away from school.

- **1 additional composition notebook will be needed for girls PE**
