2020-2021 Supply List



Caddo Parish Schools is providing two options for students in the middle school setting. Option #1 is the **hybrid learning** model, in which students will report to school 2 days a week (student last names A-L on Mondays and Wednesdays; student last names M-Z on Tuesdays and Thursdays) and receive virtual instruction from home each Friday. Option #2 is the **virtual learning** model, in which students will remain at home to receive virtual instruction via a device. Both settings will require ALL students to have a device with Wi-Fi capabilities. Students who participate in Option #1 will need a wireless device with WiFi capabilities that may be transported to and from school each day, such as a small tablet or a Chromebook. In an effort to ensure all students have an opportunity to access virtual learning in both the hybrid and virtual learning settings, Youree Drive Middle School will provide students the opportunity to check out a device for the 2020-2021 school year via a parent signed contract. Parents will be held liable if the school issued device is lost, broken, damaged, or altered for purposes other than appropriate school use. Students may use their own personal devices, however the school/district will not be responsible for loss, theft, or damage of such property. Devices are to only be used in the classroom, for educational purposes, and when designated by individual teachers. Devices will be able to connect to school WiFi while on campus and will allow students to access these valuable resources at home or from other areas with WiFi coverage while away from school. Information regarding device checkout and WiFi for students needing home access will be made available on the school website and media outlets prior to the beginning of school.

Students will carry these items daily and replace as needed during the school year:

- 1- 2 inch binder
- 1- Package of dividers
- Loose leaf paper
- Graph paper
- 1- Pencil pouch
- Pencils
- 1- Pencil sharpener with shavings holder
- Colored pencils
- Pens – red, blue, black, and green
- Highlighter
- Post-It notes
- Safety scissors
- Earbuds/phones compatible with appropriate devices in use (most students use Chromebooks)
- Composition notebooks (2 for 6th grade, 2 for 7th grade, and 1 for 8th grade)
- 4- Pocket folders (*8th grade only*)
- 2- 5-subject notebooks (*8th grade only*)
- **1 additional composition notebook will be needed for girls PE**
- **Pocket Hand Sanitizer ****
- **Disinfecting Wipes****
- **Pocket-sized tissue****

****The school will have sanitation measures in place. These items are strongly suggested to further protect student health and wellness as individual needs arise. We realize that accessing these items may be difficult, and may be purchased upon availability.**

Copies of all novels will be available in the ELA classes & library, but students will benefit from having their own copy at home. Teachers will also release virtual copies via the online learning system.
